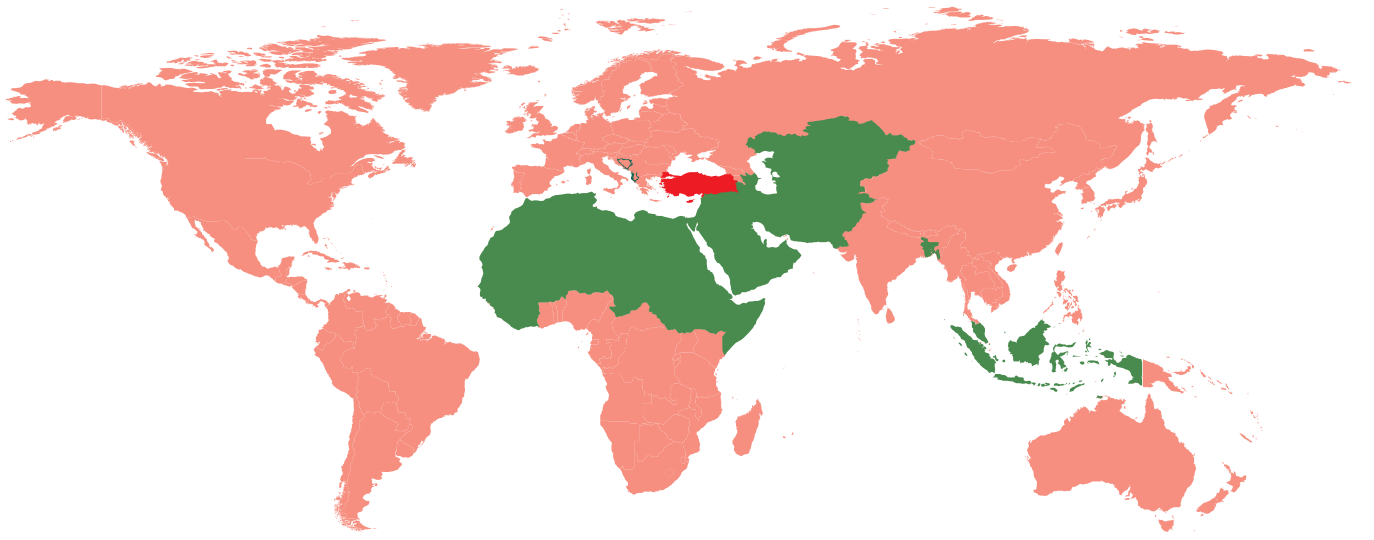

OUR MISSION

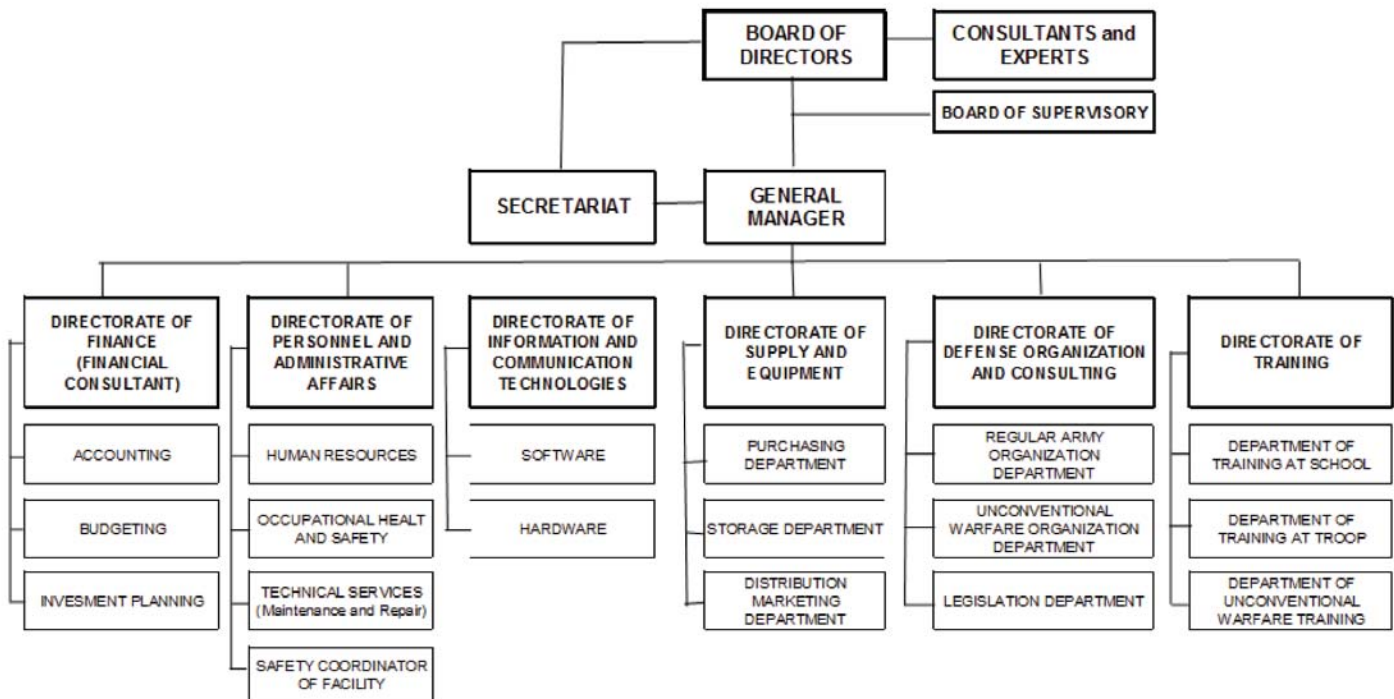

WHY “SADAT INC. INTERNATIONAL DEFENSE CONSULTING”?



■■■ Bosnia and Herzegovina

It was July, 1996.

A group of generals affiliated to Turkish Armed Forces (TSK) were assigned for a “**visit to Bosnia**” which was organized to have an on-site survey of the impacts of “Bosnian War” by a military aircraft and under the presidency of a Lieutenant General, who was then in charge as the Chief of the Operations Division of the Presidency of General Staff, and has recently been on trial for his alleged involvement in the “Sledgehammer Coup Plan” (Balyoz Darbe Planı) as the leader. I attended the mentioned group of 10 visitors during the last months of my active service.

Bosnian War, which broke out after a massacre by Serbian forces on **March 1st, 1992**, was ended by **DAYTON Peace Accord on December 14th, 1995**.

At the beginning, European States and the U.S.A. were totally reluctant to stand by Muslim citizens of Bosnia and Herzegovina who were the victims of the genocide, and they remained silent against this persecution as if they were supportive of the massacre by the Serbs; moreover, they continued to supply any kind of armament to Serbs and exerted pressure on Muslims to induce them to accept the demands of Serbs when the massacre reached its height.

In such an atmosphere of political pressure and unequal war conditions, the late Alija Izetbegovi? was forced to accept the terms imposed upon him and finally he signed “Dayton Accord” on December 14th 1995.

By virtue of the “**Dayton Accord**” which divided Bosnia and Herzegovina land into Cantons and distributed them among Bosnians, Croats and Serbs, the United States of America mandated **Muslims to destroy their weapons and to purchase US patented weapons without their spare parts**.

(European historians and commentators personally confessed that the war in Bosnia-Herzegovina once again revealed the crusader identities of the United States of America and Europe, pointing out to the fact that the West returned back to their colonist identities in the 19th century.)

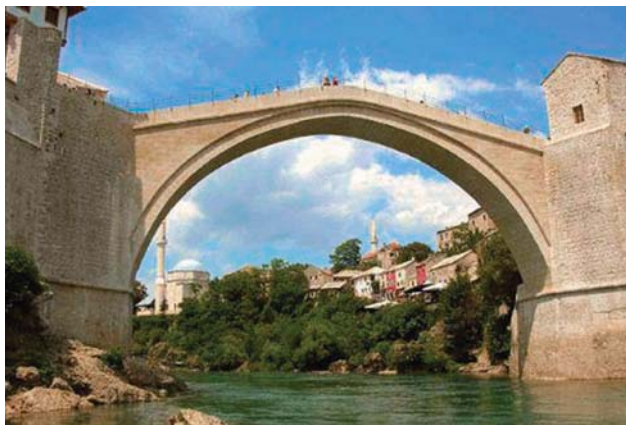
Beginning from early 1996, “Dayton Agreement” was put into effect and elements of NATO peacekeeping forces created bases in critical zones in order to maintain the peace. Finally, an atmosphere of peace was achieved in the zone.

We made the visit right after this state of high tension.

I told about the Bosnian war because I would like to share my experience in the travel.

During our long travel by plane at the date mentioned above, the Lieutenant General who led our group told us about an event. He said that a private Defense Consultancy Company from the USA referred to our

Presidency of General Staff, asking for their permission to let an active officer of TSK be assigned at their own company, and when they were asked what kind of duty he would be in charge of, they responded: “he is not required to be on duty, we need only his collaboration”. He said that, as it was found out later, the late Izetbegovi? had been asked by the mentioned private Defense

Consultancy Company to permit them to assume the works regarding constitution, training and arming of Bosnian Army, and Izetbegovi? had responded: “I will accept your offer only if it is approved by Turkey”.

When I asked the Leader of our Group how they reacted upon this offer, he replied that they fulfilled the Company’s offer and appointed a colonel on active duty for the mentioned company.

I was confused. I was thinking that recruitment of a Western company of well-known malicious intent to handle a matter, which might well have been under the control of TSK, would be very likely to mean that Turkey gives the West the green light to take the friendly Muslim Bosnia under control in the midst of their efforts to achieve their independence; and therefore, I voiced my disagreement with the accreditation of a foreign military defense consultancy company by Turkey, and I expressed my opinion to the group of persons I traveled with. As we finished our travel, we landed to Bosnia where we would perform visits for one week. We found out that the mentioned company had transformed the Bosnian Army into a structure dominated by armored units and tanks although the country had a geographical structure covered by forests and mountainous terrains. Whereas, Bosnian Armed Forces should have consisted of units which would provide commando and air-mobile operations in line with the land structure of their country. However, the Private Company and their country which supported them would not find it appropriate to constitute the mentioned units because of the fact that such units would cost less.

This memoir urged me to take a closer look at “Private Defense Consultancy Companies” under the control of the Western Capitalism. Today, there are around 70 “International Defense Consultancy Companies” which are controlled by Western developed countries and which provide service in parallel to and under the control of the armed forces and foreign affairs departments of their countries.

All of these companies were established after the World Wars I and II, and they operate in around 20 Muslim Countries. They carry out the most confidential military operations of countries in which they operate. Some of them instigated the civil war in their countries by means of imprudent leaders while some turned neighboring Muslim states into enemies, some were left behind to maintain control in lieu of the armed forces that retreated after the actual occupation and some others committed major crimes against humanity with their “hired armies”. As a result, this area was used as a means of exploitation by the West. This situation imposes a liability upon us.

When other countries needed military personnel, who have served for the long-established Turkish Armed Forces with a view to build, train and arm the Military Forces of Friendly and Muslim Countries, we were encouraged to establish the company “SADAT Inc. International Defense Consulting” in order to ensure such countries to find the opportunity which organizes skilled and idealist retired commissioned and non-commissioned officers who will attach primary importance to the national interests of such countries and the joint interests of the World of Islam, who have the profound experience of TSK, who are trained at any class and branch of the Military Department and have served in a variety of fields.

TSK serves for 22 friendly, Turk and Muslim Countries in fields of training, consultancy and arming. However, it cannot respond to all defense requirements of 60 Islamic countries.

23 founding shareholders who are supported by 64 commissioned and non-commissioned officers who successfully served in various ranks of TSK and are respectful towards religious sensitivities of Islamic Countries have established “SADAT Inc. THE FUTURE OF THE WORLD OF ISLAM AND SADAT



The beginning of the last century witnessed the fall of empires. Nations within empires were controlled by winners of the World War I in form of small states. Dependent states were condemned to totalitarian regimes even though they considered themselves independent. Dictators were protected and supported by dominating countries. Between the two world wars, developed countries of the West were rather governed by the fascist dictatorial regime while the Soviets and the dependent countries were governed by communist dictatorial regime.

After the Second World War, democratic systems modeled on the United States and England settled in the western states, while Communism was adopted as the system of government in Russia and its dependents.

The West, led by America against Communism, created NATO bloc and the Russian-led Soviet Union, created the WARSAW Pact against the raging capitalism. The past century was a period in which the armed power was emphasized, developed and promoted, and countries which could not gain their independence were exploited as a result of the clash of two superpowers and the ideologies they represent. After the World War II, the League of Nations was revised and reorganized by winners of the War (10 January 1920: 18 April 1946) and the United Nations Organization was established on October 24th, 1945.

Although the purpose of the United Nations Organization was stated as "to provide justice and security, economic development and social equality for all countries", the Western States utilized the United Nations Organization as a means to set and maintain their own system of exploitation. Deployed in Palestine as the outpost of the 27th Crusade following the Second World War and thrust like a dag into in the heart of Islamic Geography, Israel has been supported as the watchman of the Christian World and protected

by all organizations including the UN under the control of the West; which gave the world the impression as if the entire world is governed by Zionist powers and patronized the World of Islam by means of this small state, actually acting as the pawn of the West.

By the end of the century, the Soviet Union, trying to keep Afghanistan under occupation, dissolved and collapsed and the socialist ideology collapsed.

Remaining unrivaled at the beginning of this century, the USA and NATO appointed themselves as the gendarmerie of the world. The USA and its allies successively invaded Afghanistan and Iraq on the pretext that they intended to bring freedom to these countries. These two military invasions proved costly to the West, bringing their economies to a stage of downturn and convincing them of the fact that sovereignty cannot be maintained by military occupations.

Around 60 Muslim States, which are members of the United Nations, have been incapable of creating an alliance and gaining the power they deserve as they have not been able to save themselves from the control of the West and to bring their national governments into power despite their geography of high geostrategic importance, positioned at the heart

of three continents across which global land, marine and air transportation is possible, as well as their rich underground and above-ground resources and supreme spiritual values they represent.

Super and regional powers of the world (U.S.A, EU, Russia, Japan, China and India) have their eyes on the Islamic geography. To achieve political and economic interests, they struggle to establish sovereignty over Islamic countries and drift them into a state of chaos.



Together with the establishment of the republic, Turkey considered the Islamic religion, Islamic values and the civilization they represent as a threat on the assumption that it is impossible to reach up to the level of developed states without changing the society with socio-cultural revolutions.

Turning face towards the west by presenting the image of Western civilization as the ultimate goal to be achieved, our country turned its back on the Islamic States and the Muslim nations and was estranged from the Islamic world. Acting under the control of the West for a century, our country has been skeptical of Islamic States, seeing them as a threat.

This view has led to the formation of two completely dissimilar wills in the State (bureaucratic and political will) and a constant conflict between these two, eventually causing the State to squander its power on the Nation.

Keeping political will and bureaucratic authority under control, the armed forces let their fundamentalism syndrome cause religious people to feel estranged from the state; moreover, their intention to destroy religious values which are vital elements of a unified nation, and their secular nationalist attitude caused the Kurdish people to question their loyalty to the State.

The unity of the Islamic countries depends on the leadership of Turkey; and the leadership of Turkey on the Islamic countries depends on the ability to render the National Will dominant over all the institutions of the State.

The future is likely to become hard times for the Islamic countries which are on the path to choose democracy by overthrowing authoritarian governments. Young democracies which are to fight against corruption, poverty and to struggle for justice must not be left again to the control of the West to solve their enormous problems. They need solidarity and fair guides. They need economic cooperation and support, guidance in foreign policy, cooperation in defense against exploiters, and alternative systems of justice against violation of rights arising from their own countries and third countries. The welfare of Turk and Muslim Nations and restoration of peace and justice in the world hinges upon appearance of Islamic Countries as a super power on the global political scene.

SADAT Inc. has a trainer personnel portfolio including both young and experienced instructors retired from Turkish Armed Forces, with specialization in the respective branches, good qualifications and special abilities. SPECIAL FORCES ADVANCED COURSE

18 weeks duration in these courses for personnel who has followed basic course for special forces:

operation, Knows the techniques of infighting; if necessary, can uses to defend himself and to overcome the enemy while in contact with the enemy, Using the existing weapons, will be capable of a high hack, Knows survival techniques in every kind of difficult nature conditions and can uses them if necessary, Can organizes special boat operation, can attack to ships and coastal facilities with fast boat, Gets advanced level sharp shooting training and successfully completes given tasks, Wins all of the capabilities of divers under water, also reaches an additional ability to do work under water, Can continuously swims 3-4 hours with close-circuit breathing apparatus, can organizes sabotage to ships and floating units via insidious underwater attack, Can takes long distance in the air by night parachuting from high altitudes, can shock raids and surprise sabotages, Can performs every kind of helicopter operations, Knows all kind of explosives; can destroys something like vehicle, building, bridge, facility, Gained opportunity, capabilities and skills, as a warrior elements are provided to trained in with a very special and outstanding qualities.



AVIATION COURSES;

SADAT Inc. possesses the means and the capability for training the fighter pilots by way of giving the Pilot Training, Aircraft Type Training and Fight Training for any kind of aircraft and helicopter to the aviation staff of the demanding country, through three separate courses at which the pilots, which retired from the Turkish Armed Forces following a successful service, will perform duty as the instructor.

Pilot Training:

SADAT Inc. plans, coordinates and implements the pilot trainings according to the international norms in and outside Turkey. The pilot trainings may be separately planned according to the desired characteristics. The standard pilot trainings are completed within a duration of minimum 1 year and maximum 2 years. The pilot certifications are issued according to the countries concerned, or the training is completed as per the standards of such countries and the pilot certificates are enabled to be obtained.



Aircraft Type Training:

The evaluation is made by **SADAT Inc.** concerning the trainings to be given according to the other aircraft and helicopter types besides the fighter aircrafts, and the pilots with completed "Pilot training" are given the orientation flight training for the aircrafts they will fly. These aircrafts may be fighter aircrafts, transport aircrafts, tankers, AWACS

aircrafts or helicopters. Extensive investigations are made by **SADAT Inc.** for the planning and implementation in respect of the training to be given for the aircrafts being used or to be purchased by the countries, and the trainings are given with the countries' own aircrafts or in the contracted third party countries, by means of the most appropriate course plan and schedule.



Fight Training:

When demanded, the pilots having completed the Aircraft Type Training are given the fight trainings by **SADAT Inc.** in the respective country. Such trainings have a long duration and are planned in line with the needs of the demanding country. When necessary, the training programs are brought into appropriate form, considering the threat perceptions of the country.

THE WINDS OF CHANGE ON THE ISLAMIC GEOGRAPHY

CIVIL COMMOTIONS:

In **TUNISIA**, a young man named Mohamed Bouazizi attempted suicide by setting himself on fire to protest unemployment, poverty and corruption and his images spread throughout the country just to extend the scale of protests among the public, which finally turned into a civil commotion. After the refusal of General Rachid Ammar, the Army Commander to obey the order to shoot protesters, Zine El Abidine Ben Ali, the President of Tunisia, left his country and fled to Saudi Arabia after 23 years in power. Mohamed Ghannouchi, the Prime Minister of the government dissolved by Ben Ali, assumed the Presidency as required by the Tunisian Constitution; and he formed the "National Unity Government" including leaders of opposition parties in which the ministers of defense, home affairs and finance of the former government remained their positions. However, with the continuing protests, the government resigned. By the end of January, a provisional government was formed under the leadership of Mohamed Ghannouchi. The Prime Minister Ghannouchi announced that elections would be held within six months and the new government would take over.

Meanwhile in **EGYPT**; crowds of people who communicated on Google, YouTube and Twitter beginning from January 24th, 2011, decided to gather for the same reasons and selected **Tahrir Square** as the primary destination for protests. Attended by all opposition groups and even by many public institutions, the protests were led by the leaders of Muslim Brotherhood Youth and ElBaradei, **Director General** of the **International Atomic Energy Agency**, who was awarded the Nobel Prize. The protests led to the **resignation** of the 30-year **President Hosni Mubarak on February 11th, 2011**. Before that date, the Army assigned by Mubarak to disperse the crowd was reluctant to come across the public, and the pro-Israeli Omar Suleiman who was appointed as vice president resigned due to public dissent.

Finally, the caretaker government under the presidency of Ahmed Shafiq remained in power, the "Supreme Military Council" gathered all powers, as a result of which the parliament was dissolved and the Constitution was suspended. The Supreme Military Council announced that the transition period would take about 6 months during which elections would be held for the Presidency and the Parliament. Soldiers were deployed to Tahrir Square to disperse the crowds, but opposition groups remained unmoved.

Civil commotions overthrowing dictatorial regimes in Tunisia and Egypt then spread over Yemen, Jordan, Syria, Algeria and Saudi Arabia but were not as effective as in Tunisia and Egypt.

COMMON CHARACTERISTICS OF COUNTRIES IN WHICH PROTESTS ARE FOCUSED

It is questionable whether these civil commotions were triggered by national opposition groups of the Countries by their own initiatives or they were organized by the USA and the West, and whether the systems to be established subsequently will succeed in protecting their independence or end up in the same old story.

The common characteristics of Arab Countries in which civil commotions were effective are that they are governed under autocratic regime, and unemployment, poverty and corruptions influence a wide range of people. These people are in a social and political environment where freedoms are restricted, low level government officials are employed for a wage of USD 100-150, and bribery and nepotism are regarded as means of existence.

COMMON GOALS OF SUPER POWERS;

The **common goal of superpowers** like the U.S.A., EU, RUSSIA, JAPAN, CHINA and INDIA, which have been struggling for world leadership, is the **ISLAMIC GEOGRAPHY** which possesses virgin resources, strategic locations under-developed qualities. Following Iraq and Afghanistan operations, the U.S.A. admitted that this Geography cannot be controlled by **MILITARY POWER** (Invasion of Afghanistan dissolved USSR, Iraq and Afghanistan operations drove the US to crisis); **and that the control can be ensured only by means of proponent governments**. Therefore, the U.S.A. developed projects which will enable them to achieve their goals without using armed forces and facing public opposition in the target country.

THE PURPOSE OF GREATER MIDDLE EAST INITIATIVE

The purpose of "Broader Middle East and North Africa Initiative", namely the "Greater Middle East Initiative" (GMEI) is to realize an extensive "Islamic Geography" transformation strategy under the leadership of the U.S.A. comprising politics, law, information/ training, economics, social dimensions and security which address countries on a geography stretching from Mauritania, Morocco in the west, Central Asia and Mongolia in the east, Caucasus and Turkey in the north and from the Arab World to Somali in the south; aiming at a long-term change in the mentioned fields. The purpose declared by GMEI to member countries can be briefly referred to as "to democratize the countries of the Region and to ensure them to gain economic and political stability". Islamic States having geostrategic positions are



still governed under totalitarian regimes imposed between two world wars by western states of today's category of development.

Children of elite individuals of these nations complete their education in countries where there are broad freedoms and fairly shared high economic opportunities.

Acknowledging that the totalitarian systems of developed Western States, primarily of the U.S.A., on Countries of the Middle East Region will change sooner or later, they naturally intend to plan this change, which would already be inevitable otherwise, so that they will not lose control.

WHAT ARE THE INTERESTS OF MUSLIM NATIONS?

When we consider the common goals of superpowers, the Greater Middle East Initiative and protests and civil commotions all over the Islamic Geography along with Tunisia and Egypt, **it turns out to be highly probable that these movements may have been jointly planned by authoritarian governors who are in close cooperation with the US and the West.** If it is the case, this means that there are also other countries on the line.

Though outdated, it is a well-known and widely used political strategy that foreign powers expressly support the government in power in target countries while especially the illegitimate opposition receives clandestine support from these foreign powers; and the parties which are likely to provide long-term interests receive higher support and those providing no interests are deprived of support by the same foreign powers.

During the public movements in Tunisia and Egypt, military troops were not assigned before totalitarian leaders are overthrown; **the troops assumed the role of the savior of the people only after the governments were overthrown.** These strategies brings the suspicion in people's minds that new governments will be **constituted jointly by the USA, ousted leaders and Armed Forces in control.**

On the other hand, having regard to the fact that the faithful servant of the U.S.A, the overthrown President of Iraq, Saddam Hussein, who was prompted to attack Iran, declared the leader of his country and of the region in 1990s, was executed by his own exploiter after he completed his role, it must be taken into consideration that dictators on the Islamic Geography



may be cast aside after being exploited.

At this point, the important question is in which part of this game the opposition groups organizing the resistance stand, whether they are also intentionally exploited or just unaware of the situation.

With the aim to prevent Turkey, on which Muslim Nations place their hopes, and oppressed nations from being ruined in a dog-eat-dog world, contributions should be made to efforts of Muslim states on political reforms by considering their experiences as well as advantageous and disadvantageous aspects of our system and in cooperation with qualified delegations in the restructuring of their future. The issue may be either taken as a project by our Government or directed to suitable solutions by the Organization of the Islamic Conference, our universities, research centers and scientific authorities, with a view to perform research on political systems by working as a laboratory. Armed Forces of Tunisia, Egypt and other Muslim States should fill the authority gap by themselves and should not involve the army in politics. The army's task should be to protect the country against foreign threats. Even in an atmosphere of harsh debates, confrontations and even armed conflicts within the country, the army should not change its stance against foreign countries and not be involved in internal politics and security. Otherwise, neither the army can overcome the issue nor the nation can evade the Army.

Opposition groups, who led the civil uprising hold the major responsibility. They should not conflict with each other on basic issues. They should not initiate a power struggle before the system has settled. They should not cooperate with foreign forces for domestic political interests. Strictly speaking, they should not let foreign powers use them.

It is not easy to overthrow an authoritarian ruling. **Even though it is the autocratic regime that has been overthrown, it is more difficult to establish a new system instead and put it into effect.** Problems of these countries are not of such quality that can be overcome through short-term solutions. Socio-cultural, economic, technological, scientific, educational issues and problems regarding infrastructure, increase of income levels and distribution of income **can be solved no earlier than fifty years at the best when developed and modern countries are taken as basis.** The foundation of a parliamentary democratic system based on justice and the rule of law, and elimination of chaos and instability in a country requires a similar amount of time. Delays in solution of existing problems including unemployment, poverty and corruptions may increase civil unrest. Civil unrest may lead to protests and protests may result in chaos and instability.

For these reasons, Egypt, Tunisia, the other countries on the line and their allies are supposed to know that they are bound to face civil unrest and instability.

If leaders of the countries at which the winds of uprising have yet to arrive become able to initiate the normalization process without waiting for these winds, they will probably face less turmoil.

If foreign powers and the USA support a change in the Islamic Countries, this is only because they reckon that they can easily manipulate the facilities of such countries for their own interests. The countries led by cautious leaders who are able to perceive the current situation should pay efforts for the **Islamic Unity** once they have ensured **domestic unity.**

HOW IS THE PALESTINE QUESTION SOLVED?

This question will be solved with the method used by Israel, that is, when Palestine puts a military power balancing the military power of Israel up against Israel. Peaceful approaches will not bring Israel to justice. Israel relies on its power and the Western support. The weakness and the loneliness of Palestine make Israel even more aggressive. Israel will continue to exert military power on the Palestinian People until they reach their goals.



The lack of unity within the Palestinian Government is regarded strange by its allies, purported allies and open enemies. But it is **ignored** that **the land is under military occupation** by an illegitimate occupying state planning to place their people on each vulnerable and unguarded part of the land.

Does the fact that other states are not in war mean that they are in unity as regards to their domestic and foreign policies? Is it likely that they do not have any **opponents**, some of which even perform destructive acts? Under these circumstances, **how can the crack in the government of Palestine be regarded strange, even knowing that it is under occupation?** **The People of Palestine should not be treated unfairly.** The addressee should not be the actors of chaos in the territory but the parliament to receive the votes of the majority of Palestinian People, and the government to come into power with these votes. The land is to be provided with **the financial and military support needed.** This is the only way to unity.

Palestine is the common problem of Islamic countries. This is the very same for other Muslim Countries under occupation. They should be provided with the support they need.

The primary step should be to provide help to lift the blockade on Palestine.

A sea corridor should be established for Gaza and an air corridor to Ramallah so that the humanitarian aid will be securely conveyed. **The liaison of Palestine with the globe should not be left at the mercy of Israel.**

This requires open support by Islamic countries.

Every effort should be made including use of force.

The persecution on **Palestine** should be regarded as a test that should be taken by the Islamic countries, and they should avail themselves of its unifying effect.

The Islamic countries should realize their inherent power and rescue themselves from their current idle position. With one and a half billion inhabitants, underground and above-ground sources of energy, a significant geopolitical position and size enabling control over land, sea and air transportation, the World of Islam is only lack of the ability to establish the mechanisms exhibiting a joint will which would be sufficient for them to become the world's leader. **ISLAM** is adequate as a unifying factor.

And, the power required can be met by the geography possessed only if the Islamic countries act in concert.

Organization of the Islamic Conference (OIC) should be brought to a more active position.

"Islamic Conference of Ministers of Defense," should be included in the affiliates and "Standing Committee on Defense Cooperation" and "Standing Committee on Cooperation in Defense Industry" should be included in the Committees.



The Islamic countries should be brought together as follows and in view of their geopolitical positions and racial links:

- **Confederate Muslim Arab States of the Middle East** (Bahrain, United Arab Emirates, Palestine, Iraq, Qatar, Kuwait, Lebanon, Syria, Saudi Arabia, Oman, Jordan, Yemen)
- **Confederate Muslim Turk States of the Central Asia** (Azerbaijan, Kazakhstan, Kirghizstan, Turkish Republic of Northern Cyprus, Uzbekistan, Tajikistan, Turkey, Turkmenistan)
- **Confederate Muslim States of the Near East** (Afghanistan, Bangladesh, Iran, Pakistan)
- **Confederate Muslim States of the Far East** (Brunei, Indonesia, Malaysia)
- **Confederate Muslim North African States** (Algeria, Morocco, Libya, Egypt, Tunisia)
- **Confederate Muslim African States of the Ocean Basin** (Western Sahara, Benin, Burkina Faso, Chad, Ivory Coast, Gabon, Gambia, Guinea, Guinea-Bissau, Cameroon, Mali, Mauritania, Niger, Nigeria, Senegal, Sierra Leone, Togo, Guyana, Suriname)
- **Confederate Muslim African States of the Red Sea Basin** (Djibouti, Eritrea, Comoros, Mozambique, Somalia, Sudan)
- **Confederate Muslim European States**

and primarily, neighboring states should sign nonaggression treaties between each other and then **enter into Defense Cooperation Agreements**.

States which are members to Regional Unions should be unified under a federative structure and Regional Unions under a confederative structure with the ultimate goal of establishing the Islamic Unity; the efforts should be oriented towards achievement of this goal.

Although sufficient economic and technological power is an extremely important factor for the unity, **it must not be ignored that the ability to act in cooperation and to direct available sources to the same objective is a very significant factor which will accelerate the emergence of economic, technological, military and political power.**

Each of the Islamic Countries is individually dependent on **non-Muslim countries** in terms of defensive weapons. They are incapable of manufacturing a major part of their war weapons and munitions. This situation causes weakness in their defense.

This problem may easily be overcome if they unite. If the initial cooperation is realized in the Defense Industry, the Islamic Countries will become able to act more independently and have the power to prevent any potential intrusion effectively.

Establishment of Defense Industry requires technology, financial sources and a broad market.

Muslim Countries will be able to create the required conditions if they unite their facilities. Resources may be oriented towards technologically capable states. Defense needs can be met by manufacturing weapons

and munitions and unifying the manufactured items of different countries. No state would be willing to establish war industry on its own sources and technology solely for its own needs. **Turkey possesses the technology to manufacture each item of major armaments. However, the initial manufacturing process requires financial resources and continuity of the manufacturing process requires a broad market.**

If facilities are unified, the number of tanks manufactured can be increased from four - five thousand up to one hundred thousand tanks, aircrafts from five-six hundred up to ten thousand, warships from five hundred up to fifteen thousand, and helicopters from four hundred up to ten thousand.

If **Confederate Muslim States become able to manufacture their own weapons** and cooperation is established between them in terms of defense, **their resources will not be exploited by countries threatening them, and intrusions will be strictly prevented.**

This stage can be achieved within ten years at the latest.

If we set this aim for ourselves, we can actively prevent aggression towards Muslim countries.

As for Palestine:

How can PALESTINE assure a balance against the military power of Israel? If each of sixty Islamic Countries can individually grant each item of major modern combat vehicles (tanks, aircrafts, helicopters, submarines, etc.) to Palestine; if the Islamic Countries having coasts on the Mediterranean Sea, the Red Sea and the Oceans grant "NAVAL BASES"; the Islamic neighboring countries of Israel grant "ARMY BASES" and the Islamic Countries within the range

of warplanes of Israel grant "AIR BASES" to Palestine; if all Islamic countries enter into a Nonaggression and Defense Agreement with the elected de jure Government of Palestine; if they train Palestinian soldiers on bases in their country



with the granted weapons and in other military subjects; it is strongly likely that Palestine will have a modern army consisting of land, marine and air forces on military bases of allied countries in maximum five years.

A "Rapid Reaction Force" should be constituted by the Islamic Countries at Army Corps level, which will consist of armored brigade, airborne brigade and commando brigade for utilization in areas of conflict on the Islamic Geography, be affiliated to a joint command and allow land, sea and land transportation.

A FAIR, ACCEPTABLE and PERMANENT PEACE ENVIRONMENT between Palestine and Israel will be possible only after realization of these conditions.

PALESTINE SHOULD POSSESS AN ARMY AS WELL



In our article dated January 15th, 2009 entitled "Israel should be Obligated to Defensive Warfare", we tried to convey Israel's objectives with regard to the attack effected upon Gazze.

In the said article as you may recall, we expressed the objectives Israel desires to reach at as a result of this attack, after this statement we continued as follows;

"By January 20th, 2009 at the latest, thanks to the advantage gained with this attack together with the attacks that will follow, without out wearingmuch their troops, and within a very fast period of time, it is probable that Israel is aiming for Palestine and the whole world to unconditionally accept " CEASE-FIRE"

The attack ceased on January 18th, 2009, and as of January 21st, 2009, they began to withdraw. However, the conviction that the siege and blockade will continue more forcefully remains the same.

According to the declarations made by the Minister of Foreign Affairs of Israel, it is understood that the objectives behind this attack are similar to the aims we pointed out earlier.

Israel is clearly declaring the following, "as and when the need arises we shall start military operation", nobody can intervene nor impede Israel in this regard.

It is time we understood that the Christian world that placed this unruly people in the Middle East as a Trojan horse, has no intention to put an end to their massacres, on the contrary, they give them encouragement.

With the support of the Western countries, Israel bombarded the defenceless Gazze ceaselessly day and night, for a duration of 22 days with the aid of latest technology arms. People were killed and wounded. They left Gazze in ruins. But, they failed to **diminish the will - power of the People of Palestine.**

The physical goals of wars comprise of the following: to establish targets aiming at breaking down the enemy's will to fight back. But, the main aim is to break down the enemy's will to combat and thereby make them accede to their demands. As a result of this war, the determination of the People of Palestine to fight back has increased. Therefore, the winner of this war is PALESTINE.

Initially you imagine it.

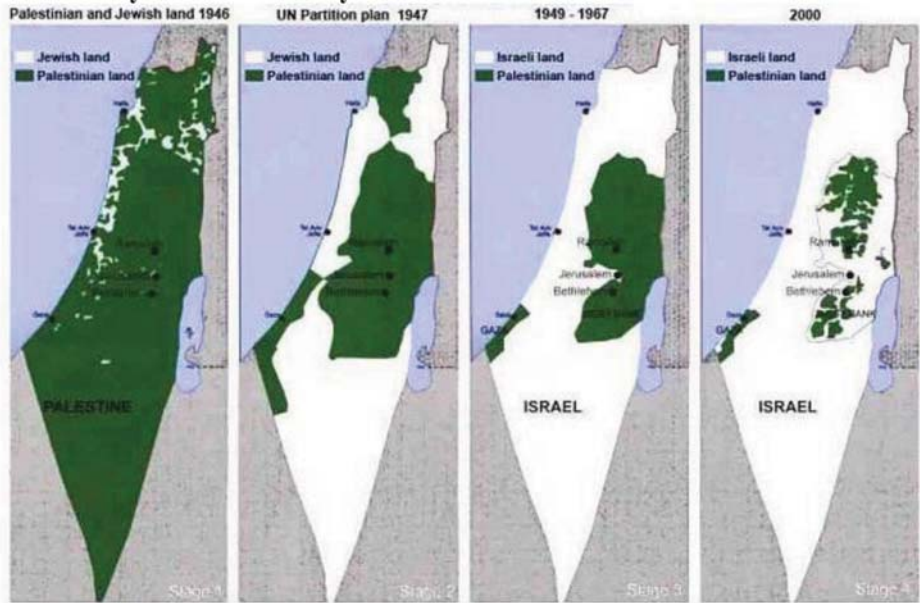
Later the concept comes into being.

Let us try to conceive an imaginary scenario vis-a-vis the future.



“In the year 2010;

Turkey invited the Defense Ministers of 57 member countries of the Organisation of the Islamic Conference (OIC,)to attend a meeting in Turkey in order to **discuss military intervention measures and determine a mutual attitude** against a possible attack on Gazze and the like attacks by Israel. The meeting held was closed to the press and lasted one week. At the end of this meeting the following declaration was announced: all the parties concerned shared the need for a “**Defense Cooperation**” to be established between the Islamic Countries and that a “**Permanent Defense Cooperation Commission**” should be established in order to realise this project.

The Prime Minister of Palestine who attended the meeting made the following declaration: in order to stop Israel and to be able to organise peace conferences on equal terms, there is a need for **a standing army endowed with modern arms**; however, **there is no possibility for establishing a standing army on Palestinian Territory** given the evident fact that the occupying country is technologically superior; and that they called upon a “**Military Base**” to be established on Islamic Countries territories in order to form air, navy and land forces and provide them training and equipment. Throughout the year, the Commission visited all the OIC member countries under the chairmanship of the Minister of Defense of Palestine.

In the year 2015;

USA proclaimed that within a period of two years, they would put an end to their military presence in Iraq. **Israel**; proclaimed that it is critically important to make a permanent peace pact with Palestine prior to the withdrawal of the USA from the Middle East, and asserted that the resistance at Gazze region must be isolated from arms, and that the blockade surrounding Gazze shall be constricted, attempts to provide all kinds of aid will be prohibited, and will build “**Jewish Settlement Places**” in northern, southern and western regions of Gazze. **Palestine**; proclaimed that the Hamas Government having elected their chairman as President and resolved their issues with El Fetih, would not accept Israel’s demands, in order to have permanent peace, Israel should withdraw from the occupied territories, alternatively, the resistance and disarmament would be out of the question.

OIC; proclaimed that an Israeli attack on Palestine would be insanity, Islamic Countries would not remain silent in such a case and would actively support Palestine.

Meanwhile the People of Palestine were getting ready for the Sacrifice Festival on “**G**” day. **Israel** gave start to air attacks on the whole of Palestine Territory.

Islamic Countries, demanded Israel to cease air attacks, **recalled their ambassadors**, and announced **the closure of air and naval areas against Israeli aircraft and warships**.

On day G+5; meanwhile Israel continued their Air raids, a **destroyer** pertaining to the Israeli Navy assigned at the Gazze blockade, **was torpedoed by a submarine** belonging to an unidentified country.

On day G+6; whilst sailing on the Mediterreanean Sea **three Israeli trade vessels were sunk** after being torpedoed by submarines.

On day G+7; **two Israeli trade vessels** and **one Israeli trade vessel were sunk** while sailing on the Red Sea and the Indian Ocean respectively.

On day G+8; Palestinian Government spokesman declared that in case the USA vessel sailing onthe Mediterreanean Sea carrying military equipment destined for Israel would not accept to change its course, then the said vessel would



be sunk, and in case where Israel would not cease the air attacks then Israel's trade vessels and warships would continue to be attacked by Palestinian Submarines.

As of the **night of G+5**, every night around 60 tanks were secretly brought inside towing vehicles from Egypt, Jordan, Saudi Arabia and deployed in protected and hidden places around Gazze.

The 6th fleet belonging to USA was sent off to the Mediterranean Sea.

On day G+10; meanwhile Israel continued with air raids, they launched land attacks. On the surrounds of Gazze, the Israelis were raided with the counter attacks from Palestinian tanks.

Armed helicopters secretly brought into Gazze from different places and from neighbouring countries launched missile attacks upon Israeli tanks deployed around Gazze.

Tonight, due to unidentifiable **10 different aircrafts** flying at low altitude and approaching from different directions **bombarded** the Israeli Parliament building, General Chief of Staff Headquarters and the Government Centre Office, afterwards, the aircrafts dropped the bombs and landed on the road at the Gazze Strip.

Palestinian Government declared that in case where Israel fails to withdraw its Land troops and stops its air attacks, **then they will launch a suicide attack on Tel Aviv with 50 loaded war planes.**

The Islamic countries announced that in case the conditions set out by the Palestinians are not accepted, they will fight against Israel alongside Palestine.

On G+11 day; UN Security Council called for immediate cease-fire, Israel was asked to withdraw its land troops. The parties announced they would comply with the armistice conditions. Israel withdrew its Land Troops.

G+20; Israel delivered a diplomatic note to each Islamic Country;

Each Islamic Country, made the following declaration: each country donated to Palestine one submarine, one war plane, one helicopter and one tank; that the Palestinian soldiers who were going to operate them were trained in some of these countries' naval, air and land bases, that until G day, the submarines, aircrafts, helicopters and tanks provided by the Countries will be shown in their own respective inventories, with the commencement of war it became known that the Palestinian Armed Forces was actually established and layed an ambush on Israel, and that they will bring this aggression to the attention of the UN...."

The realisation of the above mentioned scenario is possible. If we contemplate on it a little bit we shall understand that it is possible. A little courage and a little fervour is sufficient. Let us not fear death but rather the mortification of the after life. January 22nd, 2009.

Rocket launcher, Law, vb.), Flame throwers and fogger, Tear gas bombs, Anti-tank weapons and supplies for immediate help in the field can be made, Destroy materials, Molotov Cocktail, Fog boxes; fog, fire and grenades, Using block-making materials; courage trainees will increase by eliminating inhibitions against armored vehicles; intercepting enemy armored vehicles as non-damaged, if non-damaged seizure is not possible, to destroy them;

A VISIT TO AL-QUDS AL-SHARIF "THE NOBLE CITY" WITH FULL SPIRITUAL SATISFACTION

We were luckily bestowed a visit to **AL-Quds AL-Sharif**, which is the second city built on the Earth, and on which **AL-Masjid AL-Aqsa** is located as the first kiblah of Muslims, the third Holy Masjid in excellence, the starting point of our Holy Prophet Muhammad's (SAW) Mi'raj, and the point where the Holy Prophet led other prophets in prayer, and the site which contains sacred places of monotheistic religions, under which ten thousands of prophets are buried, and which was under the domination of Muslims for 12 centuries, the last four of which under the Ottoman rule.

We had four days of spiritual enlightenment.

We attended a Tour Organization of 160 persons, which included 23 distinguished colleagues as members of ASDER (The Association of Justice Defenders), and we landed to Tel Aviv Airport after a two-hour flight from Istanbul. Following a one-hour travel by land, we arrived at AL-Quds AL-Sharif. We performed our Friday prayer in **AL-Masjid AL-Aqsa**, or in **AL-Haram ash-Sharif** in other words which is surrounded by walls, located on a one hundred forty thousand square meter area, accessible through 17 different gates, on which **Kubbet es Sakhra**, **Masjid AL-Qiblatain** with a capacity of 5000 persons and **Masjid AL-Marwani** are located and all outdoor areas of which are full of crowds despite the heavy rain.

During the first and second days of our stay, we visited the holy places in AL-Masjid AL-Aqsa and AL-Quds AL-Sharif which are Sacred for Muslim, Christian and Jewish people. On the third day, we visited Tombs of Prophets and sacred sites in the cities of Jericho, Hebron and Bethlehem; and on the fourth day, we visited the Ottoman antiquities in the city of Jaffa before our return flight.

This is a very late visit for me. Maybe I would have delayed longer in this visit if I had not received the offer. I am in gratitude to everyone thanks to whom I made this visit.

This **visit** was very important for me in **two aspects**. The first is the **spiritual aspect** which fills our hearts, and the second aspect is the **political aspect** which reminds Muslims of their responsibility.

AL-Quds AL-Sharif is a sacred city of the same age as the history of mankind.

While praying in this holy place under the projection of the octagonal gold-plated dome of the **Kubbet es-Sakhra**, containing the **Foundation Stone** which is the point where the Holy Prophet (saw) started his Mi'raj; one can free himself from worldly matters and reach to a peaceful state of mind when he remembers that the gate opens to the ninth heaven, our Holy Prophet (saw) came into the presence of our God and the angels entered the Earth through this gate, spirits of people rise up to the sky after passing through these gates and any prayer performed in these holy places are **500 times more favorable** than prayers performed in other places except for Kaaba and Masjid-i Nabvi.

During morning and night prayer times for which we could hardly have time as we were too busy having trips in the cities, we feel a unique sense of peace and comfort in our souls and bodies, embraced by the sacred aura of the sanctuary while rushing to AL-Masjid AL-Aqsa and performing the prayers with other people from all over the world with the same excitement. This visit must be a gift bestowed upon us by our God. Our spiritual pleasure and trance reached up to its highest point when we visited the "**Al-Burak Wall**" (called as Wailing Wall by the Jewish) on the Western Wall of AL-Masjid AL-Aqsa, the place where our Holy **Prophet** tethered his winged steed, **Burak**, which took him from Makah to AL-Masjid AL-Aqsa in his Mi'raj; **Mosque of Umar (r.a.)**, subsequently built on the place where Caliph Umar (r.a.) performed his prayer right above the Church of Holy Sepulcher, adjacent to AL-Masjid AL-Aqsa in AL-Quds AL-Sharif where he arrived to take over the city after the conquest; the **Tombs of the Prophet David, Salman the Persian (r.a.)**, who was a companion of our Prophet, and **Râbi'a AL-'Adawiyya AL-Qaysiyya on the Mount of Olives** where Christians believe Jesus soared 40 days after being crucified and where the visitors can have a bird's-eye view of AL-Quds AL-Sharif and AL-Masjid AL-Aqsa; **the Tomb of Moses** near the city of **Jericho** at a one-hour distance in the North of AL-Quds AL-Sharif and the Islamic Social Complex nearby; **the Dead Sea** (al-Bahr al-

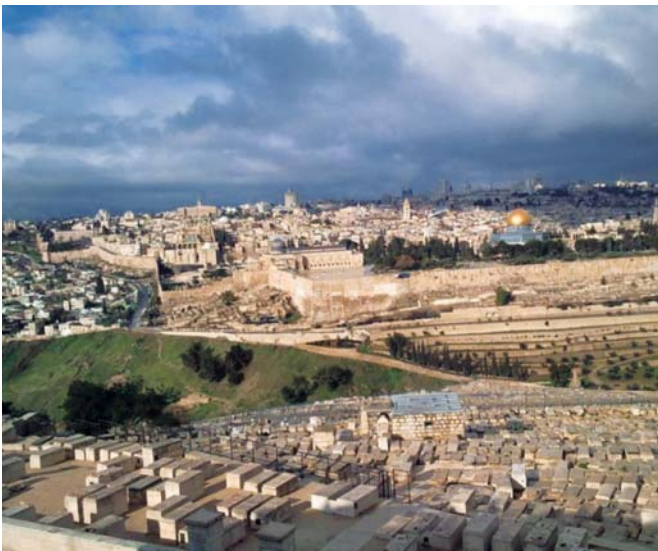
Mayyit) which is 400 m below the sea level and in geographic proximity to the ancient cities of Sodom and Gomorrah in which the Prophet Lut's peoples lived and which were destroyed; **the Tombs of Prophets Abraham, Isaac, Jacob, and Joseph, who are buried at the Islamic Social Complex called Harem-i İbrahim**, in **Hebron** which is at a distance of 50 minutes in the south of AL-Quds AL-Sharif; and **the tomb of Prophet Jonah in Halhul Town**.

While we wandered around the places of visit, we watched Christian and Jewish people rushing to their houses in their traditional worshiping clothes and Christians worshiping at the magnificent Church of Holy Sepulcher, at the church where the Virgin Mary and her parents are buried, at the church which is believed to be the place where the Jesus was born, and the Jewish worshiping at the tomb of the Prophet David and at the Wailing Wall, all praying in line with their religions and in a peaceful manner, we could not help thinking that **it would be so nice if these people looking so sincere in their worshiping were Muslims**, and we had a better understanding of the interest of Christian and Jewish people in AL-Quds AL-Sharif, which is believed to be the place where people be in the judgment day. I would like to finish writing about my personal feelings and opinions about the spiritual dimension of this visit by stating my sincere belief that **being unable to visit this holy city and the places in this city would be a critical state of spiritual deprivation for the Muslims**.

The Mournful AL-Quds AL-Sharif and the Oppressed Palestinians:

The first spiritual link between Islam and AL-Quds al-Sharif, which is the first kiblah of the Muslims, was strengthened by the event of Isra; below are the events listed chronologically about this Holy City:

In 636 (A.D.) it was conquered by Muslims, at the age of Caliph Umar (r.a.).

In 1071, the city was brought under Seljuk rule.
In 1099, the city was invaded by Crusaders and remained under the rule of Crusaders for 88 years,

In 1187, the city was brought under the rule of Salah ad-Din AL-Ayyubi,

After being under the rule of France for 11 years between **1233:1244**, the city was again conquered by the Ayyubid dynasty.

AL-Quds AL-Sharif was:

Invaded by Mongols in **1243**,

Conquered by Mamluks in **1259**,

and brought under the rule of Ottomans along with Palestine following the conquest of Egypt by Yavuz Sultân Selim Khan in **1517**.

After remaining under the Ottoman rule for 400 years.

The city was invaded by the English on **December 09, 1917**. Establishing a mandate government in Palestine, the English made AL-Quds AL-Sharif the capital of Palestine; After Israel constituted the Occupying State, the English retreated from Palestine in **1948**. Arab- Israel conflicts started from this date;

Having invaded the entire Palestine in the War of **1967**, Israel today dominates AL-QudsAL-Sharif and AL-Masjid AL-Aqsa. The State of Palestine is fully dominated by Israel. The State of Palestine is not recognized as an independent State by the World.

The State of Palestine does not have any contact with the outer world by land, sea or air.

Entrances into and exits from the settlement areas resided by the Palestinians are controlled by the Israel Army and security forces.

Settlement areas of Palestine, which are transformed into cantons disconnected from each other are surrounded by thick and high walls in an attempt to be kept under control and totally passivized.

Interprovincial highways in Palestine Territory are controlled by means of high watchtowers erected on junction and critical points, built of steel and equipped with cameras and electronic devices. Soldiers stand guard in these towers.

Moreover, new "**Jewish Settlement Areas**" have been built around Palestine Territories in form of modern sites as bases for security forces, enclosed by high wire fences. Entrances to- exits from Palestinian Settlement Areas as well as entrances to- exits from sacred places such as AL-Masjid AL-Aqsa and Harem-i İbrahim are controlled by guard boxes and outposts launched by Israeli soldiers and Security Forces. Young Palestinians are banned from performing their daily prayers regularly for five times at AL-Masjid AL-Aqsa; those who defy the ban are detected by cameras and banned from entering AL-Masjid AL-Aqsa for two months. **Maintenance and repair works of AL-Masjid AL-Aqsa are left at the mercy of Israel. This sacred place is in a miserable and forsaken situation.**

In an attempt to disconnect the most important interests of Muslims in AL-Masjid AL-Aqsa, the Israeli intends to cause

destruction of AL-Masjid AL-Aqsa under cover of searching for and locating the ruins of the Temple of Solomon by undermining AL-Masjid AL-Aqsa through underground corridors opened. Palestinians residing in AL-Quds AL-Sharif, cities of Hebron and Harem-i Sharif and Harem-i İbrahim are not let enter if they exit from these places without receiving permission of the Israeli.

In AL-Quds AL-Sharif, Palestinians are subject to pressure to sell their houses around AL-Masjid AL-Aqsa to the Israeli; owners of these houses are forced to live on the breadline, their business or employment opportunities are restricted, and residence licenses of those who find a job and have to work in a place out of AL-Quds AL-Sharif for over two years are cancelled. Palestinians cannot get repair licenses for their houses around AL-Masjid AL-Aqsa and their houses are left to fall down; those who have their houses repaired are punished with heavy fines. The Palestinian land is under a total Israeli invasion, people of Palestine are obviously forced to live like prisoners. **Palestinians are oppressed in their own lands, in a miserable, deserted and innocent condition.**

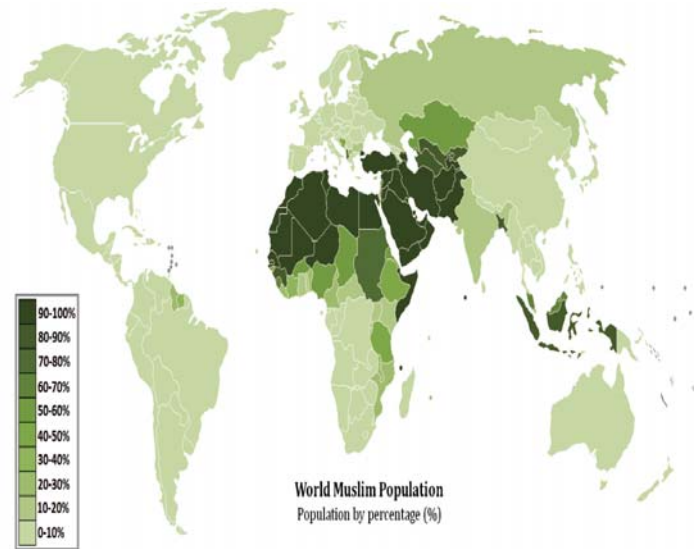
After personally observing the situation in place, we felt that we are now much more responsible towards these people and sacred places in this area.

Muslim Nations should bestow their hands on the lonely children of Islam and their abandoned Sanctuary as soon as possible.

Emergency Actions Suggested:

Every Muslim who is financially capable should visit AL-Quds AL-Sharif and Palestine and personally observe every detail in place.

Travel organizations can be referred to for this visit. Visitors coming to the land as tourists do not encounter problems at Customs Departments and checkpoints of Israel. No disturbance is experienced during travel except for obligatory security checks.



World Muslim Population

Our Group was welcomed with flowers at Tel Aviv Airport by the President of the "Union of Jews from Turkey in Israel" and their group. Travel to this country involves no risk and no security concerns. **Financial needs of Palestinian people must be met by Muslim States.**

All annual needs, current public expenses and investment payments of both Gaza and the autonomous Palestinian territory must be ascertained in conformity with the budget technique; the amount of need ascertained must be collected in a fund to be created by Muslim States, and met regularly and continuously. By means of these efforts, Palestinians will not be left at the mercy of imperialist powers which use Israel as a pawn, and they will not have to sell their houses and property or leave Palestine. Their economic and social situations should be improved and a psychological balance should be ensured between parties.

Efforts must be made to ensure Palestine to be recognized as an independent state.

By providing their contact with the outer world by land, air and sea, they should be politically supported against the invasion.

Long-Term Needs:

The following list includes organizations which are necessary not only for Palestine but also for the World of Islam. Today we may regard this as an utopia, but dream is followed by a mature project, a mature project is followed by widespread recognition and discourse and these are followed by practice. We wholeheartedly hope that these dreams and wishes of us will be realized soon.

- A "**Parliamentary Assembly**" in which Muslim Nations are fairly represented should be constituted and such assembly should perform duty on permanent basis,
- An "**Executive Committee**" should be elected and appointed by such Assembly for permanent duty,
- Such Executive Committee should pay effort to solve problems of Islamic Countries in frame of decisions to be taken by the Parliamentary Assembly,
- Annual budgets of the Parliamentary Assembly and of the Executive Committee should be funded by member countries,
- Upon an arrangement by the Executive Committee, all Ministers of Muslim Countries should convene periodically to discuss common concerns of Muslim Nations and **to ascertain common policies in field of every ministry, and especially to determine and implement the principles of common foreign policy,**
- A "**Court of Justice of Muslim Countries**" should be constituted and political solutions should be suggested for problems between member countries and other countries as well as between member countries themselves,



- A "**Cooperation in Defense and Defense Industry**" should be organized between member countries,

- A "**Rapid Reaction Force**" should be constituted through attendance of member countries to be deployed and managed by the "Executive Committee" and this military power should be exerted where required, for instance **against Israel on Palestinian lands,**

- A "**Court of Human Rights**" should be constituted under the control of the "Parliamentary Assembly" to prevent violation of human rights by member countries,

- A "**Criminal Court**" must be constituted and operationalized to adjudicate governors on the grounds of their crimes against the governed people,

A regular army should be formed for Palestine on Palestinian land and on lands of ally members through contribution of member countries,

"**Economic Cooperation**" and "**Relief Funds**" should be provided for member countries.

These can help creating an **environment of peace and reconciliation,** firstly among Islamic Countries and then **all over the world.**

Our common concern which can minimize problems in Islamic countries along with Palestine should be to implement formation of Islamic Unity within the shortest time possible.
